

# Credit Hour Log Form

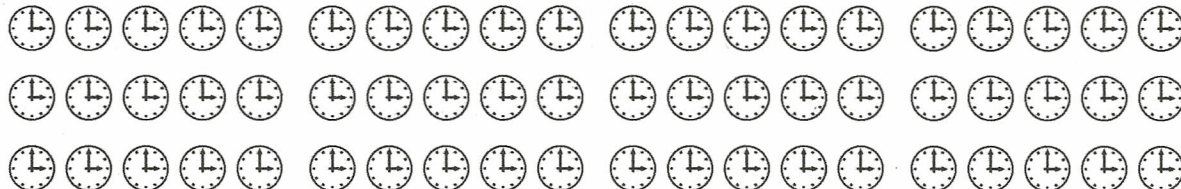
For high school credits.

By the Carnegie method: 60-90 hours on a subject =  $\frac{1}{2}$  credit and 120-180 hours = 1 credit.

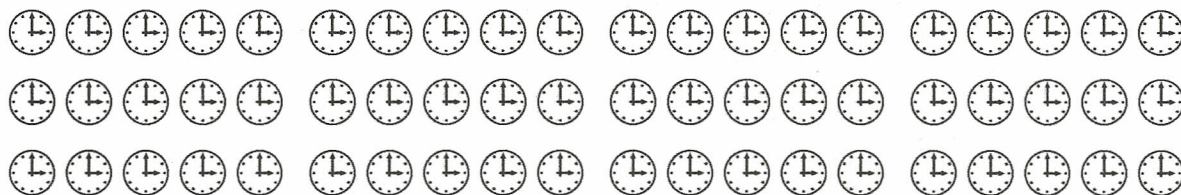
Another option: Working through at least 75% of a high school text (designed for a year-long course) = 1 credit

Directions: Shade in clocks to show time spent on a subject. Can shade  $\frac{1}{4}$  or  $\frac{1}{2}$  or other fraction if less than an hour at a time is spent. One row of clocks entirely shaded = 20 hours on that subject.

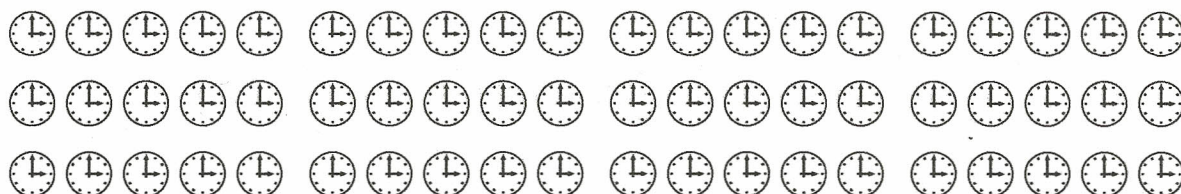
